Approximately 730,000 persons each year in US seek medical attention for a serious dog bite wound the majority of who are children and the elderly. Additionally, each year about 14 of all dog bite victims die from their injuries.

In California a dog owner is held responsible if their dog bites anyone, no matter if the dog has a history of biting or not. Whenever a dog has bitten a human on more than one occasion the city or state, attorney has the ability to bring an action against the dog owner.

How To Prevent A Dog Bite From Happening?

- Do not approach an unknown dog.
- Do not scream or run away from the dog if they are hunters in nature the animal could chase after you.
- Avoid making eye contact with an unknown dog, they can take it as a challenge and/or threat.
- If a dog approaches you remain still and calm
- If a dog does attempt to attack you or knocks you over, fall to the floor and curl into a ball covering your ears.
- If you are bitten by a dog, whether it is one you know or do not know, immediately seek medical attention and alert the authorities. If you see a stray or unknown dog in your neighborhood it is also important to alert the authorities.
